Bush Tucker Garden

In 2020, The Aboriginal Education Team was successful in securing substantial grant funds to develop a school 'Bush Tucker Garden'. The Grants were awarded as part of the School's Plus Grants (Smart Giving) funding. This project aims at developing student and community engagement with the school through the construction of a Community Bush Tucker Garden. It also endeavours to highlight the importance of Aboriginal knowledge and ways being shared and developed with our school community and the connectedness of culture to learning in our school environment.

Works began on the Garden in late 2020 and continue in 2021 and beyond.

Painting Projects

As part of the Aboriginal Education team's Engagement focus, the Team has been working with groups of students to design and paint an assortment of doors, and murals around the school to help highlight Aboriginal perspectives and create a sense of connectedness and belonging to the school. The initiative began after great success following the activity in NAIDOC week 2020. This initiative will continue throughout 2021, and is led by the Aboriginal Education Team.
