We’re looking forward to another week of connection, celebration, and community.

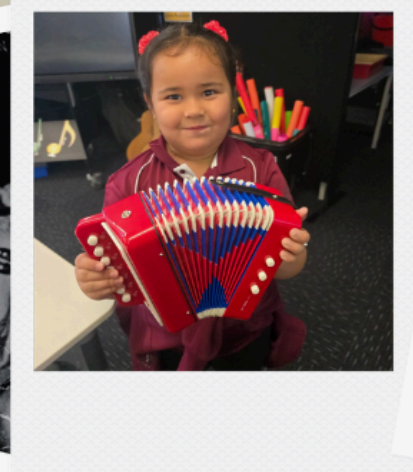
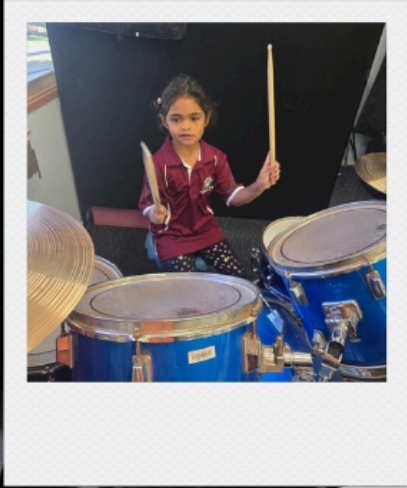

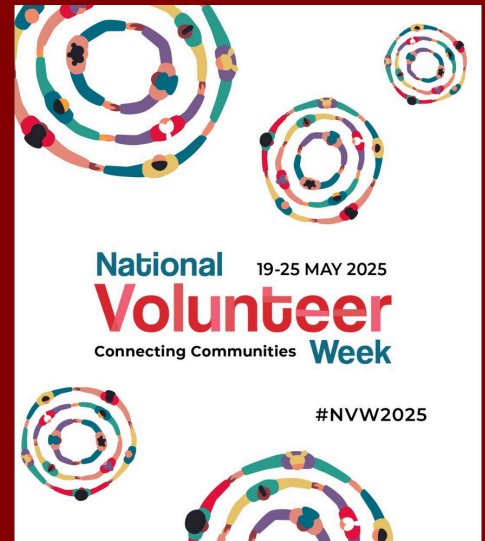
