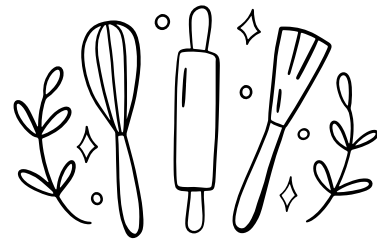
Gathering Pot Cooking Sessions
