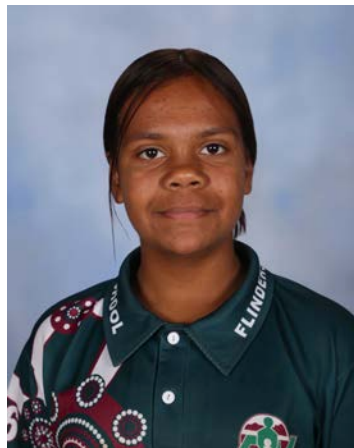

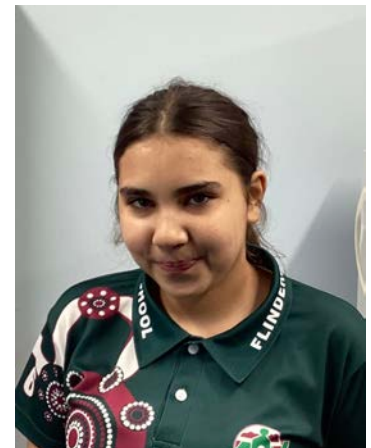

Ms Tania George will be continuing her role as Preschool Leader.

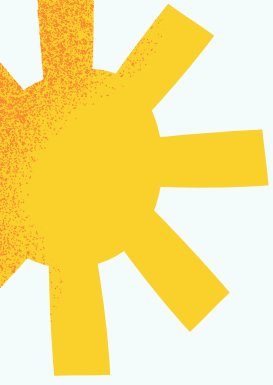
Important Preschool Info

Between 2026 and 2032 all children in South Australia will be eligible to start preschool when they turn 3 years of age. This is slowly transitioning at different sites. **Flinders View Child Parent Centre will start this in 2028.**

Right now, only 3 year old children who are Aboriginal or have extra learning needs can start at our preschool - we are not able to enroll all 3 year olds until 2028.

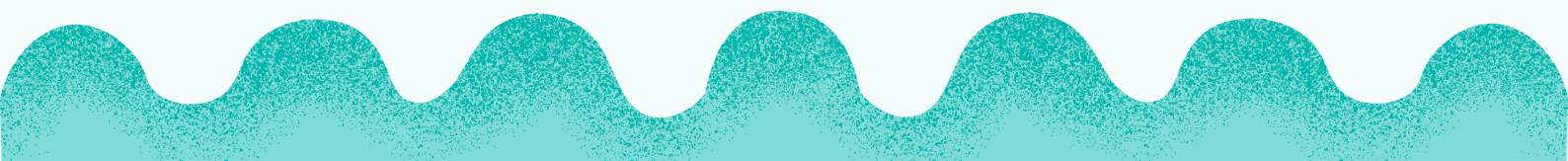
Preschool Garden

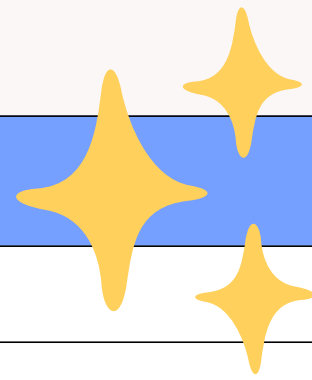
