Our doors open at 8:35am and collection time is 3:00pm.

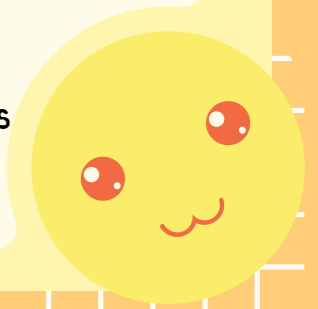

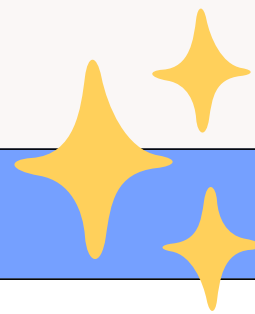

**You might like to:**


- Share a traditional story/song
