From the Principal

Dear Families,

On our recent Student Free Day, staff spent the day with Kerrie from Restorative Journeys and continued to learn about Restorative Practices and the positive impact that it is having on workplaces and schools.

Our key learnings from the day were what restorative practice is and how it supports strong relationships.

- Understanding that conflict is normal and learning pathways to repair.
- Affect biology and how emotions are experienced in the body.
- Shame as an emotional driver and the importance of repair.
- The Compass of Shame and recognising "spikey" moments.
- Restorative Questions and their practical application
- Introduction to sharing circles and how to implement them into our classes.

The day prior to our SFD, we were fortunate to have Kerrie join us and work with all of our classes, educating students about recognising spikey moments, how to move from spikey to open to ensure we don't stay spikey, along with an introduction to restorative questions that students can use themselves when there has been a problem.

Our older students also looked at the compass of shame and how it can impact our behaviour. Kerrie was very impressed with our students knowledge and engagement in the sessions.

Healthy Breakfast/Recess Recipe

BERRY & COCONUT CHIA PUDDING

Ingredients

- 2 ½ cup (625ml) coconut milk
- ⅓ cup (55g) chia seeds
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 tbs honey or maple syrup
- 1 banana, chopped
- 3 cups mixed berries - fresh or frozen

Method

1. Place coconut milk, seeds, extract and honey in a large bowl; cover and refrigerate for 1 hour or overnight until thick.
2. Mix coconut mixture with chopped banana and mixed berries. Divide into bowls and top with remaining fruit to serve.

Squishy's Obstacle Course - Nevaeh, Zarlee, Shayarnah - Complete the course to win a prize.

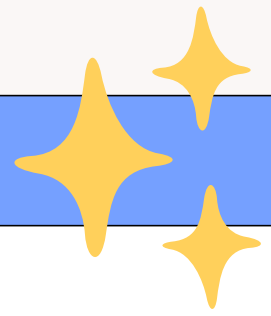
Come Sponge Bob - Makhi, Aaliyah, Ayana, Anoeliah - Throw a dripping wet sponge at SpongeBob Squarepants.



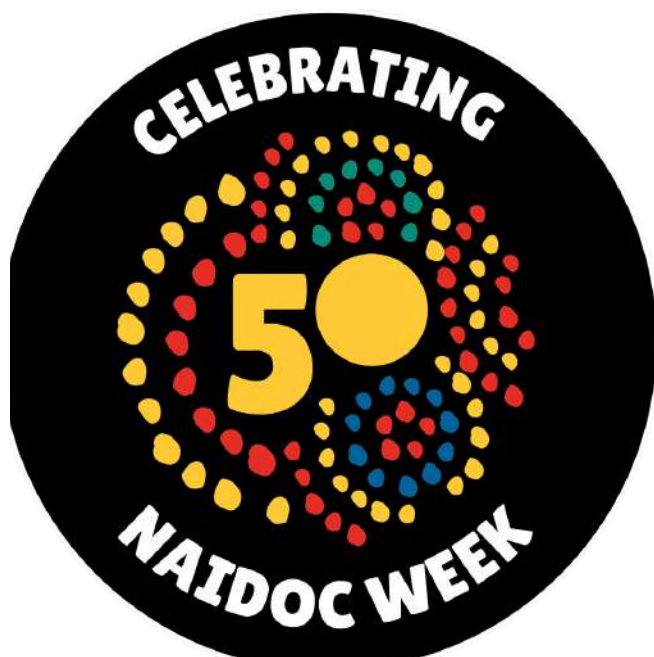
