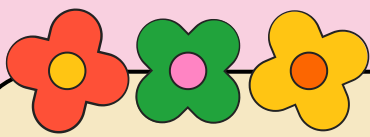
We believe that every day at school counts for every child. Regular school attendance is vital for your child's learning, social development and future opportunities.

We understand there are times when absence is unavoidable, however attending school everyday helps your child build strong relationships, keep up with their learning and develop positive routines.

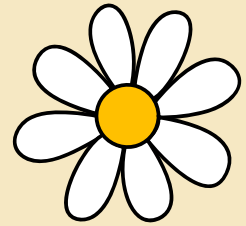
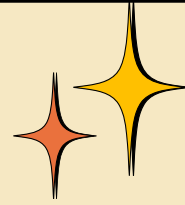

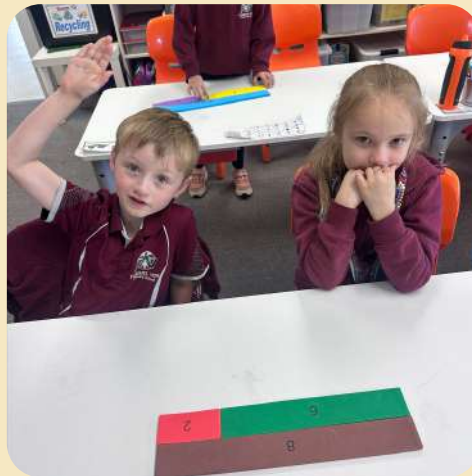
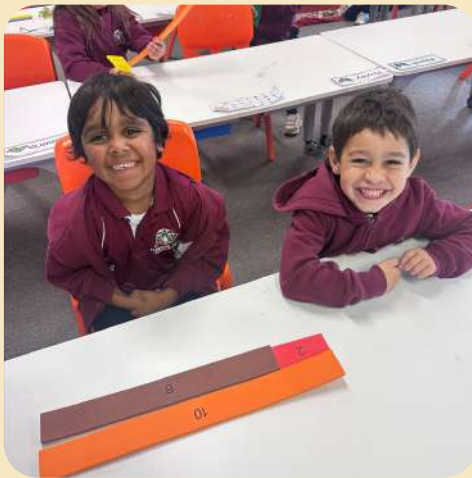


ROOM 19 MATHS

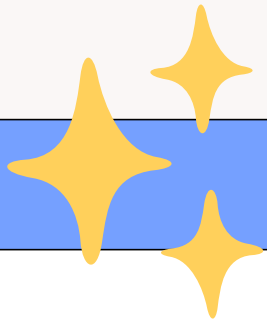


About Our Learning
